



# JOEL LESSON 14

## THE HOLY SPIRIT



### #1 Genesis 1:2

The earth was without form and void, and darkness was over the face of the deep. And the **Spirit** of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

### #2 Genesis 6:3

Then the LORD said, "My **Spirit** shall not abide in man forever, for he is flesh: his days shall be 120 years."

### #3 Genesis 41:38

And Pharaoh said to his servants, "Can we find a man like this, in whom is the **Spirit** of God?"

### #4 Exodus 31:3

and I have filled him with the **Spirit** of God, with ability and intelligence, with knowledge and all craftsmanship,

### #5 Exodus 35:31

and he has filled him with the **Spirit** of God, with skill, with intelligence, with knowledge, and with all craftsmanship,

### #6 Numbers 11:17

And I will come down and talk with you there. And I will take some of the **Spirit** that is on you and put it on them, and they shall bear the burden of the people with you, so that you may not bear it yourself alone.

### #7 Numbers 11:25-26

Then the LORD came down in the cloud and spoke to him, and took some of the **Spirit** that was on him and put it on the seventy elders. And as soon as the **Spirit** rested on them, they prophesied. But they did not continue doing it. Now two men remained in the camp, one named Eldad, and the other named Medad, and the **Spirit** rested on them. They were among those registered, but they had not gone out to the tent, and so they prophesied in the camp.

### #8 Numbers 11:29

But Moses said to him, "Are you jealous for my sake? Would that all the LORD's people were prophets, that the LORD would put his **Spirit** on them!"

### #9 Numbers 24:2

And Balaam lifted up his eyes and saw Israel camping tribe by tribe. And the **Spirit** of God came upon him,

### #10 Numbers 27:18

So the LORD said to Moses, "Take Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the **Spirit**, and lay your hand on him.

### #11 Judges 3:10

The **Spirit** of the LORD was upon him, and he judged Israel. He went out to war, and the LORD gave Cushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand. And his hand prevailed over Cushan-rishathaim.

### #12 Judges 6:34

But the **Spirit** of the LORD clothed Gideon, and he sounded the trumpet, and the Abiezrites were called out to follow him.

### #13 Judges 11:29

Then the **Spirit** of the LORD was upon Jephthah, and he passed through Gilead and Manasseh and passed on to Mizpah of Gilead, and from Mizpah of Gilead he passed on to the Ammonites.

### #14 Judges 13:25

And the **Spirit** of the LORD began to stir him in Mahanehdan, between Zorah and Eshtaol.

### #15 Judges 14:6

Then the **Spirit** of the LORD rushed upon him, and although he had nothing in his hand, he tore the lion in pieces as one tears a young goat. But he did not tell his father or his mother what he had done.

### #16 Judges 14:19

And the **Spirit** of the LORD rushed upon him, and he went down to Ashkelon and struck down thirty men of the town and took their spoil and gave the garments to those who had told the riddle. In hot anger he went back to his father's house.

### #17 Judges 15:14

When he came to Lehi, the Philistines came shouting to meet him. Then the **Spirit** of the LORD rushed upon him, and the ropes that were on his arms became as flax that has caught fire, and his bonds melted off his hands.

### #18 1 Samuel 10:6

Then the **Spirit** of the LORD will rush upon you, and you will prophesy with them and be turned into another man.

### #19 1 Samuel 10:10

When they came to Gibeah, behold, a group of prophets met him, and the **Spirit** of God rushed upon him, and he prophesied among them.

### #20 1 Samuel 11:6

And the **Spirit** of God rushed upon Saul when he heard these words, and his anger was greatly kindled.

### #21 1 Samuel 16:13-14

Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers. And the **Spirit** of the LORD rushed upon David from that day forward. And Samuel rose up and went to Ramah. Now the **Spirit** of the LORD departed from Saul, and a harmful spirit from the LORD tormented him.

### #22 1 Samuel 19:20

Then Saul sent messengers to take David, and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing as head over them, the **Spirit** of God came upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

### #23 1 Samuel 19:23

And he went there to Naioth in Ramah. And the **Spirit** of God came upon him also, and as he went he prophesied until he came to Naioth in Ramah.

### #24 2 Samuel 23:2

The **Spirit** of the LORD speaks by me; his word is on my tongue.

### #25 1 Kings 18:12

And as soon as I have gone from you, the **Spirit** of the LORD will carry you I know not where. And so, when I come and tell Ahab and he cannot find you, he will kill me, although I your servant have feared the LORD from my youth.

### #26 1 Kings 22:24

Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near and struck Micaiah on the cheek and said, "How did the **Spirit** of the LORD go from me to speak to you?"

### #27 2 Kings 2:16

And they said to him, "Behold now, there are with your servants fifty strong men. Please let them go and seek your master. It may be that the **Spirit** of the LORD has caught him up and cast him upon some mountain or into some valley." And he said, "You shall not send."

### #28 1 Chronicles 12:18

Then the **Spirit** clothed Amasai, chief of the thirty, and he said, "We are yours, O David, and with you, O son of Jesse! Peace, peace to you, and peace to your helpers! For your God helps you." Then David received them and made them officers of his troops.

### #29 2 Chronicles 15:1

The **Spirit** of God came upon Azariah the son of Oded,

### #30 2 Chronicles 18:23

Then Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah came near and struck Micaiah on the cheek and said, "Which way did the **Spirit** of the LORD go from me to speak to you?"

### #31 2 Chronicles 20:14

And the **Spirit** of the LORD came upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, son of Benaiah, son of Jeiel, son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly.

### #32 2 Chronicles 24:20

Then the **Spirit** of God clothed Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, and he stood above the people, and said to them, "Thus says God, 'Why do you break the commandments of the LORD, so that you cannot prosper? Because you have forsaken the LORD, he has forsaken you.'"

### #33 Nehemiah 9:20

You gave your good **Spirit** to instruct them and did not withhold your manna from their mouth and gave them water for their thirst.

### #34 Nehemiah 9:30

Many years you bore with them and warned them by your **Spirit** through your prophets. Yet they would not give ear. Therefore you gave them into the hand of the peoples of the lands.

### #35 Job 33:4

The **Spirit** of God has made me, and the breath of the Almighty gives me life.

### #36 Psalm 51:11

Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your **Holy Spirit** from me.

### #37 Psalm 104:30

When you send forth your **Spirit**, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground.

### #38 Psalm 106:33 (LSB)

Because they were rebellious against His **Spirit**, He spoke rashly with his lips.

### #39 Psalm 139:7

Where shall I go from your **Spirit**? Or where shall I flee from your presence?

### #40 Psalm 143:10

Teach me to do your will, for you are my God! Let your good **Spirit** lead me on level ground!

### #41 Isaiah 11:2

And the **Spirit** of the LORD shall rest upon him, the **Spirit** of wisdom and understanding, the **Spirit** of counsel and might, the **Spirit** of knowledge and the fear of the LORD.

### #42 Isaiah 30:1

"Ah, stubborn children," declares the LORD, "who carry out a plan, but not mine, and who make an alliance, but not of my **Spirit**, that they may add sin to sin;

### #43 Isaiah 32:15

until the **Spirit** is poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness becomes a fruitful field, and the fruitful field is deemed a forest.

### #44 Isaiah 34:16

Seek and read from the book of the LORD: Not one of these shall be missing; none shall be without her mate. For the mouth of the LORD has commanded, and his **Spirit** has gathered them.

### #45 Isaiah 40:13

Who has measured the **Spirit** of the LORD, or what man shows him his counsel?

### #46 Isaiah 42:1

Behold my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen, in whom my soul delights; I have put my **Spirit** upon him; he will bring forth justice to the nations.

### #47 Isaiah 44:3

For I will pour water on the thirsty land, and streams on the dry ground; I will pour my **Spirit** upon your offspring, and my blessing on your descendants.

### #48 Isaiah 48:16

Draw near to me, hear this: from the beginning I have not spoken in secret, from the time it came to be I have been there." And now the Lord GOD has sent me, and his **Spirit**.

### #49 Isaiah 59:21

"And as for me, this is my covenant with them," says the LORD: "My **Spirit** that is upon you, and my words that I have put in your mouth, shall not depart out of your mouth, or out of the mouth of your offspring, or out of the mouth of your children's offspring," says the LORD, "from this time forth and forevermore."

### #50 Isaiah 61:1

The **Spirit** of the Lord GOD is upon me, because the LORD has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

### #51 Isaiah 63:10-11

But they rebelled and grieved his **Holy Spirit**; therefore he turned to be their enemy, and himself fought against them. Then he remembered the days of old, of Moses and his people. Where is he who brought them up out of the sea with the shepherds of his flock? Where is he who put in the midst of them his **Holy Spirit**,

### #52 Isaiah 63:14

Like livestock that go down into the valley, the **Spirit** of the LORD gave them rest. So you led your people, to make for yourself a glorious name.

### #53 Ezekiel 2:2

And as he spoke to me, the **Spirit** entered into me and set me on my feet, and I heard him speaking to me.

### #54 Ezekiel 3:12-14

Then the **Spirit** lifted me up, and I heard behind me the voice of a great earthquake: "Blessed be the glory of the LORD from its place!" It was the sound of the wings of the living creatures as they touched one another, and the sound of the wheels beside them, and the sound of a great earthquake. The **Spirit** lifted me up and took me away, and I went in bitterness in the heat of my spirit, the hand of the LORD being strong upon me.

### #55 Ezekiel 3:24

But the **Spirit** entered into me and set me on my feet, and he spoke with me and said to me, "Go, shut yourself within your house.

### #56 Ezekiel 8:3

He put out the form of a hand and took me by a lock of my head, and the **Spirit** lifted me up between earth and heaven and brought me in visions of God to Jerusalem, to the entrance of the gateway of the inner court that faces north, where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provokes to jealousy.

### #57 Ezekiel 11:1

The **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me to the east gate of the house of the LORD, which faces east. And behold, at the entrance of the gateway there were twenty-five men. And I saw among them Jaazaniah the son of Azzur, and Pelatiah the son of Benaiah, princes of the people.

### #58 Ezekiel 11:5

And the **Spirit** of the LORD fell upon me, and he said to me, "Say, Thus says the LORD: So you think, O house of Israel. For I know the things that come into your mind.

### #59 Ezekiel 11:24

And the **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me in the vision by the **Spirit** of God into Chaldea, to the exiles. Then the vision that I had seen went up from me.

### #60 Ezekiel 36:27

And I will put my **Spirit** within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.

\* All verses are from the English Standard Version (ESV) except for the following 8 verses that are from the Legacy Standard Bible (LSB): #38, 66, 72, 225, 236, 242, 247, 248.

**(#61) Ezekiel 37:1**

The hand of the LORD was upon me, and he brought me out in the **Spirit** of the LORD and set me down in the middle of the valley; it was full of bones.

**(#62) Ezekiel 37:14**

And I will put my **Spirit** within you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I am the LORD; I have spoken, and I will do it, declares the LORD."

**(#63) Ezekiel 39:29**

And I will not hide my face anymore from them, when I pour out my **Spirit** upon the house of Israel, declares the Lord GOD."

**(#64) Ezekiel 43:5**

the **Spirit** lifted me up and brought me into the inner court; and behold, the glory of the LORD filled the temple.

**(#65) Joel 2:28-29**

And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my **Spirit** on all flesh; your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, and your young men shall see visions. Even on the male and female servants in those days I will pour out my **Spirit**.

**(#66) Micah 2:7 (LSB)**

Is it being said, O house of Jacob: 'Is the **Spirit** of Yahweh impatient? Are these His deeds?' Do not My words do good To the one walking uprightly?

**(#67) Micah 3:8**

But as for me, I am filled with power, with the **Spirit** of the LORD, and with justice and might, to declare to Jacob his transgression and to Israel his sin.

**(#68) Haggai 2:5**

according to the covenant that I made with you when you came out of Egypt. My **Spirit** remains in your midst. Fear not.

**(#69) Zechariah 4:6**

Then he said to me, "This is the word of the LORD to Zerubbabel: Not by might, nor by power, but by my **Spirit**, says the LORD of hosts.

**(#70) Zechariah 6:8**

Then he cried to me, "Behold, those who go toward the north country have set my **Spirit** at rest in the north country."

**(#71) Zechariah 7:12**

They made their hearts diamond-hard lest they should hear the law and the words that the LORD of hosts had sent by his **Spirit** through the former prophets. Therefore great anger came from the LORD of hosts.

**(#72) Zechariah 12:10 (LSB)**

And I will pour out on the house of David and on the inhabitants of Jerusalem the **Spirit** of grace and of supplication, so that they will look on Me whom they have pierced; and they will mourn for Him, as one mourns for an only son, and they will weep bitterly over Him like the bitter weeping over a firstborn.

**(#73) Malachi 2:15**

Did he not make them one, with a portion of the **Spirit** in their union? And what was the one God seeking? Godly offspring. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and let none of you be faithless to the wife of your youth.

**(#74) Matthew 1:18-20**

Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the **Holy Spirit**. And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly. But as he considered these things, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not fear to take Mary as your wife, for that which is conceived in her is from the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#75) Matthew 3:11**

I baptize you with water for repentance, but he who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit** and fire.

**(#76) Matthew 3:16**

And when Jesus was baptized, immediately he went up from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened to him, and he saw the **Spirit** of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him;

**(#77) Matthew 4:1**

Then Jesus was led up by the **Spirit** into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

**(#78) Matthew 10:20**

For it is not you who speak, but the **Spirit** of your Father speaking through you.

**(#79) Matthew 12:18**

Behold, my servant whom I have chosen, my beloved with whom my soul is well pleased. I will put my **Spirit** upon him, and he will proclaim justice to the Gentiles.

**(#80) Matthew 12:28**

But if it is by the **Spirit** of God that I cast out demons, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

**(#81) Matthew 12:31-32**

Therefore I tell you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven people, but the blasphemy against the **Spirit** will not be forgiven. And whoever speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but whoever speaks against the **Holy Spirit** will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come.

**(#82) Matthew 22:43**

He said to them, "How is it then that David, in the **Spirit**, calls him Lord, saying,

**(#83) Matthew 28:19**

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#84) Mark 1:8-12**

I have baptized you with water, but he will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit**." In those days Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee and was baptized by John in the Jordan. And when he came up out of the water, immediately he saw the heavens being torn open and the **Spirit** descending on him like a dove. And a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." The **Spirit** immediately drove him out into the wilderness.

**(#85) Mark 3:29**

but whoever blasphemes against the **Holy Spirit** never has forgiveness, but is guilty of an eternal sin"—

**(#86) Mark 12:36**

David himself, in the **Holy Spirit**, declared, "The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet."

**(#87) Mark 13:11**

And when they bring you to trial and deliver you over, do not be anxious beforehand what you are to say, but say whatever is given you in that hour, for it is not you who speak, but the **Holy Spirit**.

**(#88) Luke 1:15**

for he will be great before the Lord. And he must not drink wine or strong drink, and he will be filled with the **Holy Spirit**, even from his mother's womb.

**(#89) Luke 1:35**

And the angel answered her, "The **Holy Spirit** will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore the child to be born will be called holy—the Son of God.

**(#90) Luke 1:41**

And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#91) Luke 1:67**

And his father Zechariah was filled with the **Holy Spirit** and prophesied, saying,

**(#92) Luke 2:25-27**

Now there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon, and this man was righteous and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the **Holy Spirit** was upon him. And it had been revealed to him by the **Holy Spirit** that he would not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ. And he came in the **Spirit** into the temple, and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him according to the custom of the Law,

**(#93) Luke 3:16**

John answered them all, saying, "I baptize you with water, but he who is mightier than I is coming, the strap of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the **Holy Spirit** and fire.

**(#94) Luke 3:22**

and the **Holy Spirit** descended on him in bodily form, like a dove; and a voice came from heaven, "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased."

**(#95) Luke 4:1**

And Jesus, full of the **Holy Spirit**, returned from the Jordan and was led by the **Spirit** in the wilderness

**(#96) Luke 4:14**

And Jesus returned in the power of the **Spirit** to Galilee, and a report about him went out through all the surrounding country.

**(#97) Luke 4:18**

The **Spirit** of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed,

**(#98) Luke 10:21**

In that same hour he rejoiced in the **Holy Spirit** and said, "I thank you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hidden these things from the wise and understanding and revealed them to little children; yes, Father, for such was your gracious will.

**(#99) Luke 11:13**

If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the heavenly Father give the **Holy Spirit** to those who ask him!"

**(#100) Luke 12:10-12**

And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but the one who blasphemes against the **Holy Spirit** will not be forgiven. And when they bring you before the synagogues and the rulers and the authorities, do not be anxious about how you should defend yourself or what you should say, for the **Holy Spirit** will teach you in that very hour what you ought to say."

**(#101) John 1:32-33**

And John bore witness: "I saw the **Spirit** descend from heaven like a dove, and it remained on him. I myself did not know him, but he who sent me to baptize with water said to me, "He on whom you see the **Spirit** descend and remain, this is he who baptizes with the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#102) John 3:5-8**

Jesus answered, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the **Spirit**, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the **Spirit** is spirit. Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the **Spirit**."

**(#103) John 3:34**

For he whom God has sent utters the words of God, for he gives the **Spirit** without measure.

**(#104) John 6:63**

It is the **Spirit** who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.

**(#105) John 7:39**

Now this he said about the **Spirit**, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the **Spirit** had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

**(#106) John 14:16-17**

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Helper, to be with you forever, even the **Spirit** of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees him nor knows him. You know him, for he dwells with you and will be in you.

**(#107) John 14:26**

But the Helper, the **Holy Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.

**(#108) John 15:26**

But when the Helper comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the **Spirit** of truth, who proceeds from the Father, he will bear witness about me.

**(#109) John 16:7-8**

Nevertheless, I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send him to you. And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment:

**(#110) John 16:13-14**

When the **Spirit** of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth, for he will not speak on his own authority, but whatever he hears he will speak, and he will declare to you the things that are to come. He will glorify me, for he will take what is mine and declare it to you.

**(#111) John 20:22**

And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#112) Acts 1:2**

until the day when he was taken up, after he had given commands through the **Holy Spirit** to the apostles whom he had chosen.

**(#113) Acts 1:5**

for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the **Holy Spirit** not many days from now."

**(#114) Acts 1:8**

But you will receive power when the **Holy Spirit** has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."

**(#115) Acts 1:16**

Brothers, the Scripture had to be fulfilled, which the **Holy Spirit** spoke beforehand by the mouth of David concerning Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus.

**(#116) Acts 2:4**

And they were all filled with the **Holy Spirit** and began to speak in other tongues as the **Spirit** gave them utterance.

**(#117) Acts 2:17-18**

And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my **Spirit** on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams; even on my male servants and female servants in those days I will pour out my **Spirit**, and they shall prophesy.

**(#118) Acts 2:33**

Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the **Holy Spirit**, he has poured out this that you yourselves are seeing and hearing.

**(#119) Acts 2:38**

And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#120) Acts 4:8**

Then Peter, filled with the **Holy Spirit**, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders,

**(#121) Acts 4:25**

who through the mouth of our father David, your servant, said by the **Holy Spirit**, "Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples plot in vain?"

**(#122) Acts 4:31**

And when they had prayed, the place in which they were gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the **Holy Spirit** and continued to speak the word of God with boldness.

**(#123) Acts 5:3**

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the **Holy Spirit** and to keep back for yourself part of the proceeds of the land?"



**(#124) Acts 5:9**

But Peter said to her, "How is it that you have agreed together to test the **Spirit** of the Lord? Behold, the feet of those who have buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out."

**(#125) Acts 5:32**

And we are witnesses to these things, and so is the **Holy Spirit**, whom God has given to those who obey him."

**(#126) Acts 6:3-5**

Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the **Spirit** and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty. But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the **Holy Spirit**, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch.

**(#127) Acts 6:10**

But they could not withstand the wisdom and the **Spirit** with which he was speaking.

**(#128) Acts 7:51**

You stiff-necked people, uncircumcised in heart and ears, you always resist the **Holy Spirit**. As your fathers did, so do you.

**(#129) Acts 7:55**

But he, full of the **Holy Spirit**, gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at the right hand of God.

**(#130) Acts 8:15-19**

who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the **Holy Spirit**, for he had not yet fallen on any of them, but they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they laid their hands on them and they received the **Holy Spirit**. Now when Simon saw that the **Spirit** was given through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, saying, "Give me this power also, so that anyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#131) Acts 8:29**

And the **Spirit** said to Philip, "Go over and join this chariot."

**(#132) Acts 8:39**

And when they came up out of the water, the **Spirit** of the Lord carried Philip away, and the eunuch saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing.

**(#133) Acts 9:17**

So Ananias departed and entered the house. And laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus who appeared to you on the road by which you came has sent me so that you may regain your sight and be filled with the **Holy Spirit**."

**(#134) Acts 9:31**

So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria had peace and was being built up. And walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the **Holy Spirit**, it multiplied.

**(#135) Acts 10:19**

And while Peter was pondering the vision, the **Spirit** said to him, "Behold, three men are looking for you.

**(#136) Acts 10:38**

how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the **Holy Spirit** and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

**(#137) Acts 10:44-47**

While Peter was still saying these things, the **Holy Spirit** fell on all who heard the word. And the believers from among the circumcised who had come with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the **Holy Spirit** was poured out even on the Gentiles. For they were hearing them speaking in tongues and extolling God. Then Peter declared, "Can anyone withhold water for baptizing these people, who have received the **Holy Spirit** just as we have?"

**(#138) Acts 11:12**

And the **Spirit** told me to go with them, making no distinction. These six brothers also accompanied me, and we entered the man's house.

**(#139) Acts 11:15-16**

As I began to speak, the **Holy Spirit** fell on them just as on us at the beginning. And I remembered the word of the Lord, how he said, 'John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the **Holy Spirit**.'

**(#140) Acts 11:24**

for he was a good man, full of the **Holy Spirit** and of faith. And a great many people were added to the Lord.

**(#141) Acts 11:28**

And one of them named Agabus stood up and foretold by the **Spirit** that there would be a great famine over all the world (this took place in the days of Claudius).

**(#142) Acts 13:2-4**

While they were worshipping the Lord and fasting, the **Holy Spirit** said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Then after fasting and praying they laid their hands on them and sent them off. So, being sent out by the **Holy Spirit**, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus.

**(#143) Acts 13:9**

But Saul, who was also called Paul, filled with the **Holy Spirit**, looked intently at him

**(#144) Acts 13:52**

And the disciples were filled with joy and with the **Holy Spirit**.

**(#145) Acts 15:8**

And God, who knows the heart, bore witness to them, by giving them the **Holy Spirit** just as he did to us,

**(#146) Acts 15:28**

For it has seemed good to the **Holy Spirit** and to us to lay on you no greater burden than these requirements:

**(#147) Acts 16:6-7**

And they went through the region of Phrygia and Galatia, having been forbidden by the **Holy Spirit** to speak the word in Asia. And when they had come up to Mysia, they attempted to go into Bithynia, but the **Spirit** of Jesus did not allow them.

**(#148) Acts 19:2**

And he said to them, "Did you receive the **Holy Spirit** when you believed?" And they said, "No, we have not even heard that there is a **Holy Spirit**."

**(#149) Acts 19:6**

And when Paul had laid his hands on them, the **Holy Spirit** came on them, and they began speaking in tongues and prophesying.

**(#150) Acts 19:21**

Now after these events Paul resolved in the **Spirit** to pass through Macedonia and Achaia and go to Jerusalem, saying, "After I have been there, I must also see Rome."

**(#151) Acts 20:22-23**

And now, behold, I am going to Jerusalem, constrained by the **Spirit**, not knowing what will happen to me there, except that the **Holy Spirit** testifies to me in every city that imprisonment and afflictions await me.

**(#152) Acts 20:28**

Pay careful attention to yourselves and to all the flock, in which the **Holy Spirit** has made you overseers, to care for the church of God, which he obtained with his own blood.

**(#153) Acts 21:4**

And having sought out the disciples, we stayed there for seven days. And through the **Spirit** they were telling Paul not to go on to Jerusalem.

**(#154) Acts 21:11**

And coming to us, he took Paul's belt and bound his own feet and hands and said, "Thus says the **Holy Spirit**, 'This is how the Jews at Jerusalem will bind the man who owns this belt and deliver him into the hands of the Gentiles.'"

**(#155) Acts 28:25**

And disagreeing among themselves, they departed after Paul had made one statement: "The **Holy Spirit** was right in saying to your fathers through Isaiah the prophet:

**(#156) Romans 1:4**

and was declared to be the Son of God in power according to the **Spirit** of holiness by his resurrection from the dead, Jesus Christ our Lord,

**(#157) Romans 2:29**

But a Jew is one inwardly, and circumcision is a matter of the heart, by the **Spirit**, not by the letter. His praise is not from man but from God.

**(#158) Romans 5:5**

and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the **Holy Spirit** who has been given to us.

**(#159) Romans 7:6**

But now we are released from the law, having died to that which held us captive, so that we serve in the new way of the **Spirit** and not in the old way of the written code.

**(#160) Romans 8:2-6**

For the law of the **Spirit** of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the **Spirit**. For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the **Spirit** set their minds on the things of the **Spirit**. For to set the mind on the flesh is death, but to set the mind on the **Spirit** is life and peace.

**(#161) Romans 8:9-16**

You, however, are not in the flesh but in the **Spirit**, if in fact the **Spirit** of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the **Spirit** of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the **Spirit** is life because of righteousness. If the **Spirit** of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his **Spirit** who dwells in you. So then, brothers, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the **Spirit** you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the **Spirit** of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the **Spirit** of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" The **Spirit** himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,

**(#162) Romans 8:23**

And not only the creation, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the **Spirit**, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for adoption as sons, the redemption of our bodies.

**(#163) Romans 8:26-27**

Likewise the **Spirit** helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the **Spirit** himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the **Spirit**, because the **Spirit** intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

**(#164) Romans 9:1**

I am speaking the truth in Christ—I am not lying; my conscience bears me witness in the **Holy Spirit**—

**(#165) Romans 14:17**

For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and peace and joy in the **Holy Spirit**.

**(#166) Romans 15:13**

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the **Holy Spirit** you may abound in hope.

**(#167) Romans 15:16**

to be a minister of Christ Jesus to the Gentiles in the priestly service of the gospel of God, so that the offering of the Gentiles may be acceptable, sanctified by the **Holy Spirit**.

**(#168) Romans 15:19**

by the power of signs and wonders, by the power of the **Spirit** of God—so that from Jerusalem and all the way around to Illyricum I have fulfilled the ministry of the gospel of Christ;

**(#169) Romans 15:30**

I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the **Spirit**, to strive together with me in your prayers to God on my behalf,

**(#170) 1 Corinthians 2:4**

and my speech and my message were not in plausible words of wisdom, but in demonstration of the **Spirit** and of power,

**(#171) 1 Corinthians 2:10-14**

these things God has revealed to us through the **Spirit**. For the **Spirit** searches everything, even the depths of God. For who knows a person's thoughts except the spirit of that person, which is in him? So also no one comprehends the thoughts of God except the **Spirit** of God. Now we have received not the spirit of the world, but the **Spirit** who is from God, that we might understand the things freely given us by God. And we impart this in words not taught by human wisdom but taught by the **Spirit**, interpreting spiritual truths to those who are spiritual. The natural person does not accept the things of the **Spirit** of God, for they are folly to him, and he is not able to understand them because they are spiritually discerned.

**(#172) 1 Corinthians 3:16**

Do you not know that you are God's temple and that God's **Spirit** dwells in you?

**(#173) 1 Corinthians 6:11**

And such were some of you. But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the **Spirit** of our God.

**(#174) 1 Corinthians 6:19**

Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the **Holy Spirit** within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own,

**(#175) 1 Corinthians 7:40**

Yet in my judgment she is happier if she remains as she is. And I think that I too have the **Spirit** of God.

**(#176) 1 Corinthians 12:3-4**

Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking in the **Spirit** of God ever says "Jesus is accursed!" and no one can say "Jesus is Lord" except in the **Holy Spirit**. Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same **Spirit**;

**(#177) 1 Corinthians 12:7-13**

To each is given the manifestation of the **Spirit** for the common good. For to one is given through the **Spirit** the utterance of wisdom, and to another the utterance of knowledge according to the same **Spirit**, to another faith by the same **Spirit**, to another gifts of healing by the one **Spirit**, to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another the ability to distinguish between spirits, to another various kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues. All these are empowered by one and the same **Spirit**, who apportions to each one individually as he wills. For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one **Spirit** we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one **Spirit**.

**(#178) 1 Corinthians 14:2**

For one who speaks in a tongue speaks not to men but to God; for no one understands him, but he utters mysteries in the **Spirit**.

**(#179) 1 Corinthians 14:12**

So with yourselves, since you are eager for manifestations of the **Spirit**, strive to excel in building up the church.

**(#180) 2 Corinthians 1:22**

and who has also put his seal on us and given us his **Spirit** in our hearts as a guarantee.

**(#181) 2 Corinthians 3:3**

And you show that you are a letter from Christ delivered by us, written not with ink but with the **Spirit** of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts.

**(#182) 2 Corinthians 3:6-8**

who has made us sufficient to be ministers of a new covenant, not of the letter but of the **Spirit**. For the letter kills, but the **Spirit** gives life. Now if the ministry of death, carved in letters on stone, came with such glory that the Israelites could not gaze at Moses' face because of its glory, which was being brought to an end, will not the ministry of the **Spirit** have even more glory?

**(#183) 2 Corinthians 3:17-18**

Now the Lord is the **Spirit**, and where the **Spirit** of the Lord is, there is freedom. And we all, with unveiled face, beholding the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from one degree of glory to another. For this comes from the Lord who is the **Spirit**.

**(#184) 2 Corinthians 5:5**

He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the **Spirit** as a guarantee.

**(#185) 2 Corinthians 6:6**

by purity, knowledge, patience, kindness, the **Holy Spirit**, genuine love;

**(#186) 2 Corinthians 13:14**

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the **Holy Spirit** be with you all.

**(#187) Galatians 3:2-5**

Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the **Spirit** by works of the law or by hearing with faith? Are you so foolish? Having begun by the **Spirit**, are you now being perfected by the flesh? Did you suffer so many things in vain—if indeed it was in vain? Does he who supplies the **Spirit** to you and works miracles among you do so by works of the law, or by hearing with faith—

**(#188) Galatians 3:14**

so that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we might receive the promised **Spirit** through faith.

**(#189) Galatians 4:6**

And because you are sons, God has sent the **Spirit** of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!"

**(#190) Galatians 4:29**

But just as at that time he who was born according to the flesh persecuted him who was born according to the **Spirit**, so also it is now.

**(#191) Galatians 5:5**

For through the **Spirit**, by faith, we ourselves eagerly wait for the hope of righteousness.

**(#192) Galatians 5:16-18**

But I say, walk by the **Spirit**, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the **Spirit**, and the desires of the **Spirit** are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. But if you are led by the **Spirit**, you are not under the law.

**(#193) Galatians 5:22-23**

But the fruit of the **Spirit** is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

**(#194) Galatians 5:25**

If we live by the **Spirit**, let us also keep in step with the **Spirit**.

**(#195) Galatians 6:8**

For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the **Spirit** will from the **Spirit** reap eternal life.

**(#196) Ephesians 1:13-14**

In him you also, when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation, and believed in him, were sealed with the promised **Holy Spirit**, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it, to the praise of his glory.

**(#197) Ephesians 1:17**

that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give you the **Spirit** of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of him,

**(#198) Ephesians 2:18**

For through him we both have access in one **Spirit** to the Father.

**(#199) Ephesians 2:22**

In him you also are being built together into a dwelling place for God by the **Spirit**.

**(#200) Ephesians 3:5**

which was not made known to the sons of men in other generations as it has now been revealed to his holy apostles and prophets by the **Spirit**.

**(#201) Ephesians 3:16**

that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his **Spirit** in your inner being,

**(#202) Ephesians 4:3-4**

eager to maintain the unity of the **Spirit** in the bond of peace. There is one body and one **Spirit**—just as you were called to the one hope that belongs to your call—

**(#203) Ephesians 4:30**

And do not grieve the **Holy Spirit** of God, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption.

**(#204) Ephesians 5:18**

And do not get drunk with wine, for that is debauchery, but be filled with the **Spirit**,

**(#205) Ephesians 6:17-18**

and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the **Spirit**, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the **Spirit**, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,

**(#206) Philippians 1:19**

for I know that through your prayers and the help of the **Spirit** of Jesus Christ this will turn out for my deliverance,

**(#207) Philippians 2:1**

So if there is any encouragement in Christ, any comfort from love, any participation in the **Spirit**, any affection and sympathy,

**(#208) Philippians 3:3**

For we are the circumcision, who worship by the **Spirit** of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh—

**(#209) Colossians 1:8**

and has made known to us your love in the **Spirit**.

**(#210) 1 Thessalonians 1:5-6**

because our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the **Holy Spirit** and with full conviction. You know what kind of men we proved to be among you for your sake. And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#211) 1 Thessalonians 4:8**

Therefore whoever disregards this, disregards not man but God, who gives his **Holy Spirit** to you.

**(#212) 1 Thessalonians 5:19**

Do not quench the **Spirit**.

**(#213) 2 Thessalonians 2:13**

But we ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers beloved by the Lord, because God chose you as the firstfruits to be saved, through sanctification by the **Spirit** and belief in the truth.

**(#214) 1 Timothy 3:16**

Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the **Spirit**, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory.

**(#215) 1 Timothy 4:1**

Now the **Spirit** expressly says that in later times some will depart from the faith by devoting themselves to deceitful spirits and teachings of demons,

**(#216) 2 Timothy 1:14**

By the **Holy Spirit** who dwells within us, guard the good deposit entrusted to you.

**(#217) Titus 3:5**

he saved us, not because of works done by us in righteousness, but according to his own mercy, by the washing of regeneration and renewal of the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#218) Hebrews 2:4**

while God also bore witness by signs and wonders and various miracles and by gifts of the **Holy Spirit** distributed according to his will.

**(#219) Hebrews 3:7**

Therefore, as the **Holy Spirit** says, "Today, if you hear his voice,

**(#220) Hebrews 6:4**

For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#221) Hebrews 9:8**

By this the **Holy Spirit** indicates that the way into the holy places is not yet opened as long as the first section is still standing

**(#222) Hebrews 9:14**

how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal **Spirit** offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.

**(#223) Hebrews 10:15**

And the **Holy Spirit** also bears witness to us; for after saying,

**(#224) Hebrews 10:29**

How much worse punishment, do you think, will be deserved by the one who has trampled underfoot the Son of God, and has profaned the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has outraged the **Spirit** of grace?

**(#225) James 4:5 (LSB)**

Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: "He jealously desires the **Spirit** which He has made to dwell in us?"

**(#226) 1 Peter 1:2**

according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in the sanctification of the **Spirit**, for obedience to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his blood: May grace and peace be multiplied to you.

**(#227) 1 Peter 1:11-12**

inquiring what person or time the **Spirit** of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories. It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the **Holy Spirit** sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

**(#228) 1 Peter 4:14**

If you are insulted for the name of Christ, you are blessed, because the **Spirit** of glory and of God rests upon you.

**(#229) 2 Peter 1:21**

For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the **Holy Spirit**.

**(#230) 1 John 3:24**

Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, and God in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the **Spirit** whom he has given us.

**(#231) 1 John 4:2**

By this you know the **Spirit** of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God,

**(#232) 1 John 4:6**

We are from God. Whoever knows God listens to us; whoever is not from God does not listen to us. By this we know the **Spirit** of truth and the spirit of error.

**(#233) 1 John 4:13**

By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his **Spirit**.

**(#234) 1 John 5:6-8**

This is he who came by water and blood—Jesus Christ; not by the water only but by the water and the blood. And the **Spirit** is the one who testifies, because the **Spirit** is the truth. For there are three that testify: the **Spirit** and the water and the blood; and these three agree.

**(#235) Jude 19-20**

It is these who cause divisions, worldly people, devoid of the **Spirit**. But you, beloved, building yourselves up in your most holy faith and praying in the **Holy Spirit**,

**(#236) Revelation 1:4 (LSB)**

John to the seven churches that are in Asia: Grace to you and peace, from the One who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven **Spirits** who are before His throne,

**(#237) Revelation 1:10**

I was in the **Spirit** on the Lord's day, and I heard behind me a loud voice like a trumpet

**(#238) Revelation 2:7**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches. To the one who conquers I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the paradise of God.'

**(#239) Revelation 2:11**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches. The one who conquers will not be hurt by the second death.'

**(#240) Revelation 2:17**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches. To the one who conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, with a new name written on the stone that no one knows except the one who receives it.'

**(#241) Revelation 2:29**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.'

**(#242) Revelation 3:1 (LSB)**

And to the angel of the church in Sardis write: This is what He who has the seven **Spirits** of God and the seven stars, says: 'I know your deeds, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.

**(#243) Revelation 3:6**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.'

**(#244) Revelation 3:13**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.'

**(#245) Revelation 3:22**

He who has an ear, let him hear what the **Spirit** says to the churches.'

**(#246) Revelation 4:2**

At once I was in the **Spirit**, and behold, a throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne.

**(#247) Revelation 4:5 (LSB)**

And he carried me away in the **Spirit** into a wilderness, and I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast that was full of blasphemous names, and it had seven heads and ten horns.

**(#251) Revelation 21:10**

And he carried me away in the **Spirit** to a great, high mountain, and showed me the holy city Jerusalem coming down out of heaven from God,

**(#252) Revelation 22:17**

The **Spirit** and the Bride say, "Come." And let the one who hears say, "Come." And let the one who is thirsty come; let the one who desires take the water of life without price.
